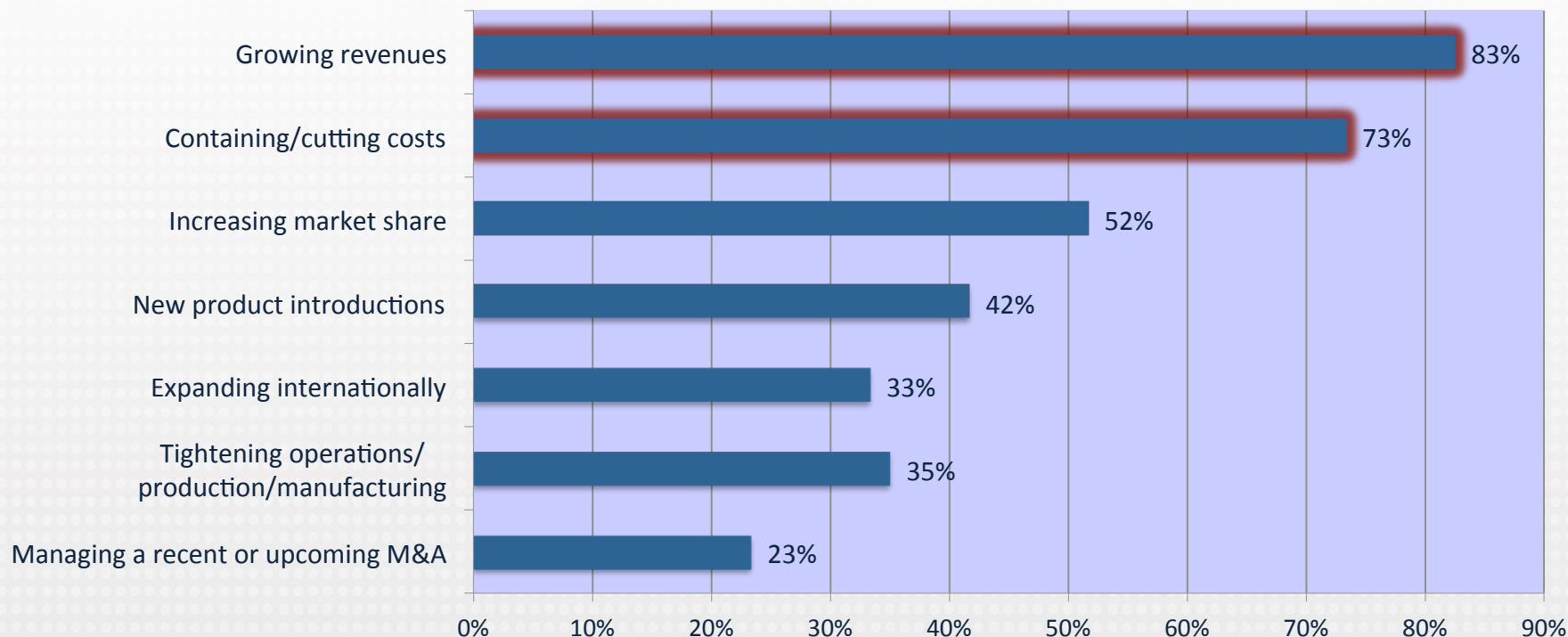
Program Overview

- Gatepoint Research invited 1,273 selected operations, manufacturing, finance, supply chain, IT, and MIS executives to participate in a survey themed *Optimization Trends In ERP Usage*.
- Candidates were invited via email and 120 executives have participated to date.
- Survey participants are overwhelmingly senior decision-makers; 99% work at Director level or above; 71% of responders are VPs or CxOs.
- 45% of responders work for corporations in the Fortune 1,000.
- 100% of responders participated voluntarily; none were engaged using telemarketing.

Observations and Conclusions

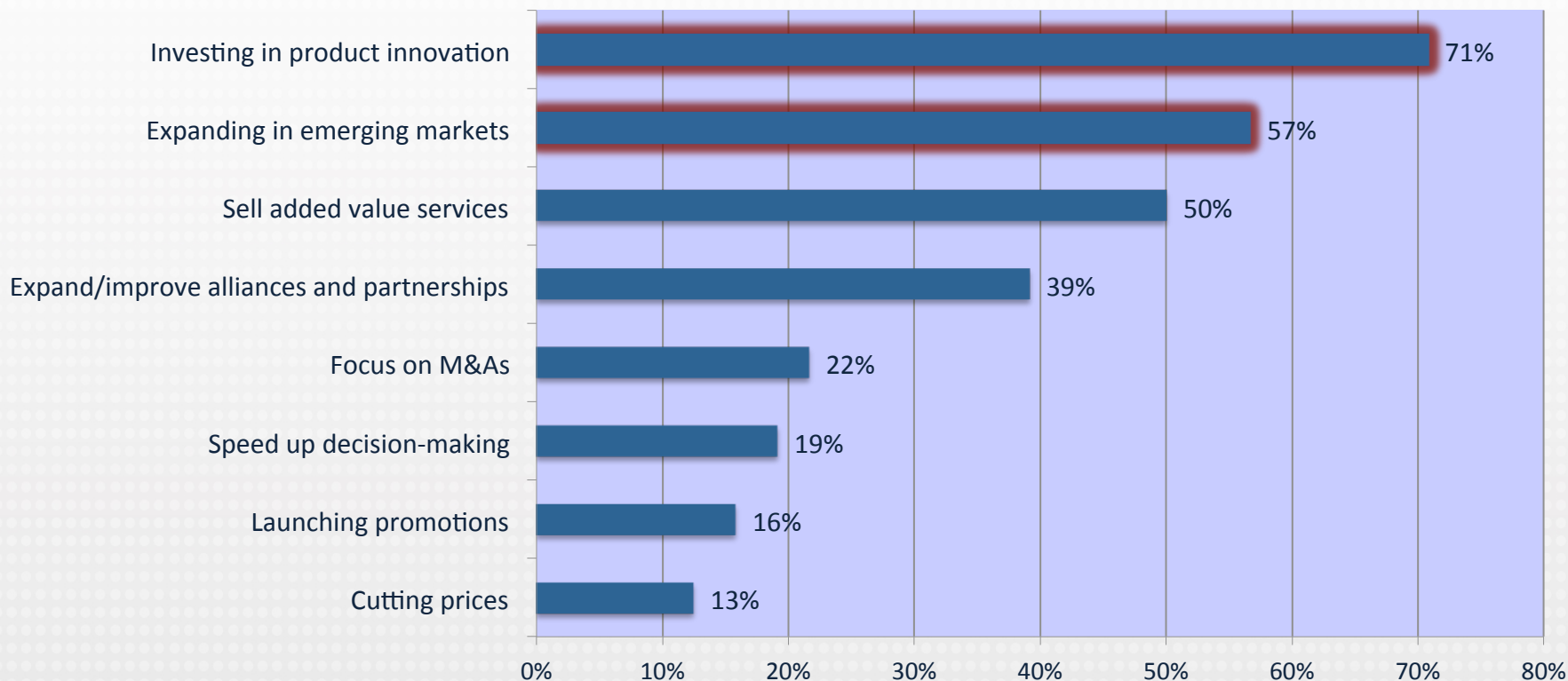
- Financials are what keep executives up at night: growing revenue (83%) and cost cutting (73%) are the highest priorities for the next 18 months.
- To grow revenue, most responders feel they should focus on product innovation (71%) and expanding in emerging markets (57%).
- 74% of responders are looking to optimize their production process; demand forecasting (49%) and inventory management (44%) show the most potential for process improvement.
- Manufacturing operations are increasingly complex – 38% report that their operations are very or extremely complex.
- Nearly a third (29%) forecast a trend towards even greater complexity; 87% rate addressing its challenges as 3 or above on a 5 point scale.

What are your company's priorities for the next 18 months?



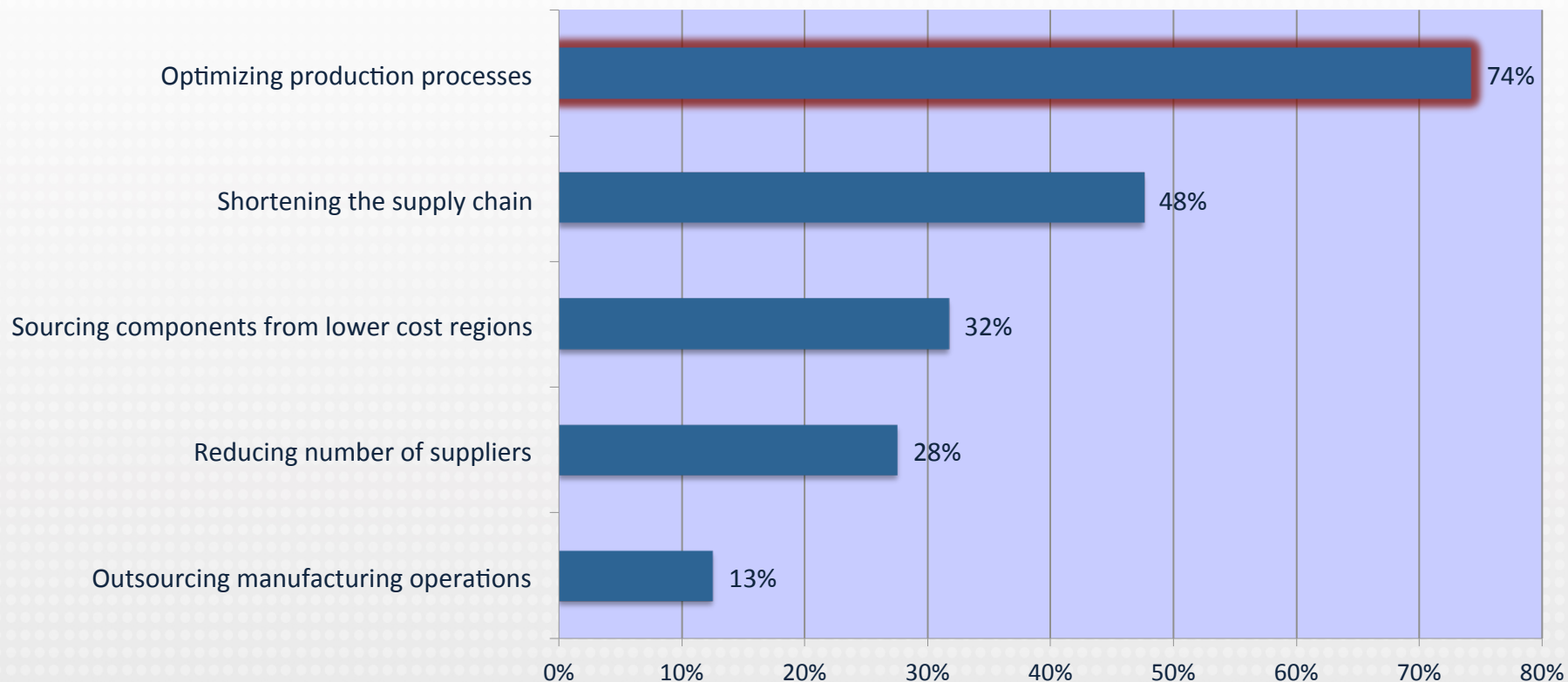
Revenue and cost cutting top the list of priorities for the next 18 months.

Which of the following tactics are used to grow revenue?



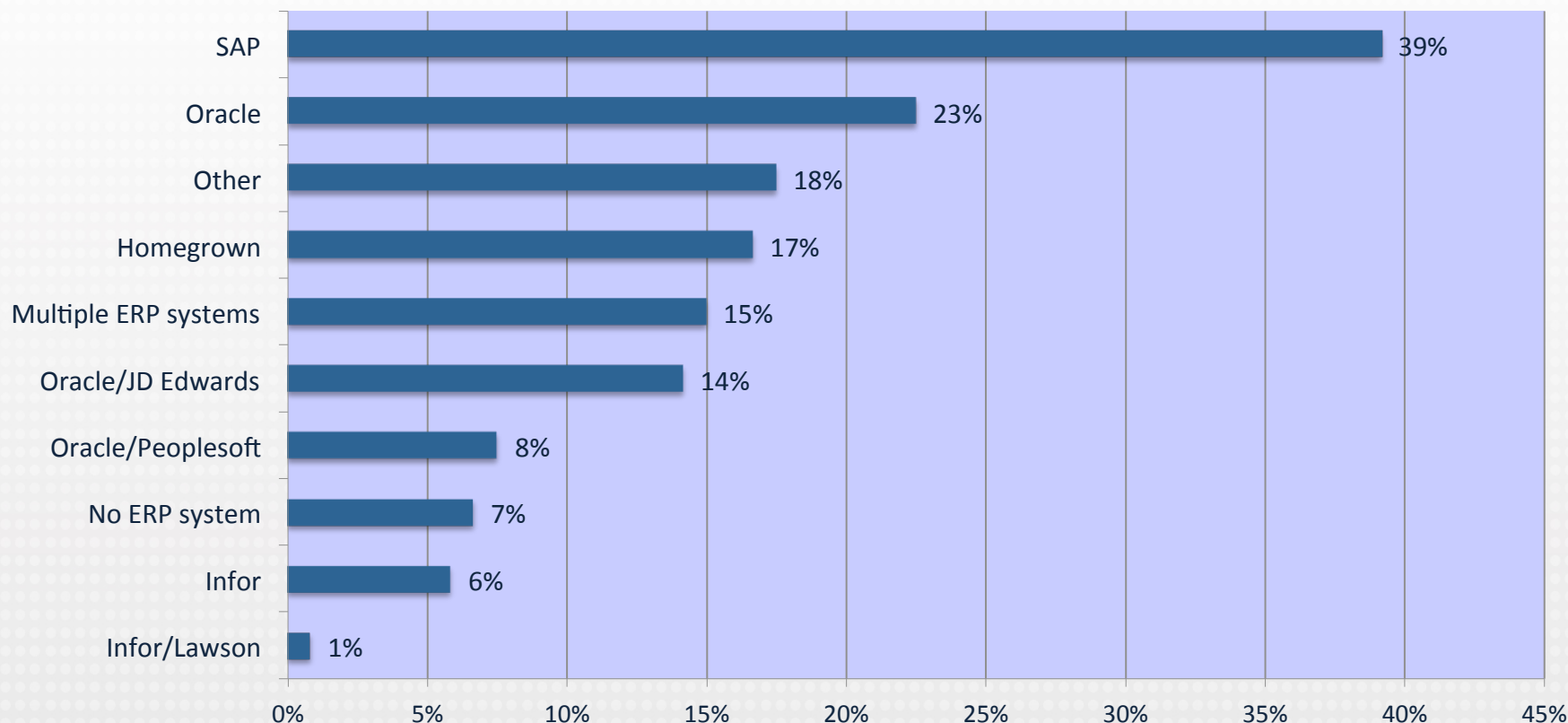
Responders focus on product innovation and expanding in emerging markets in order to grow revenue.

Regarding your manufacturing operations, which of these are you exploring?



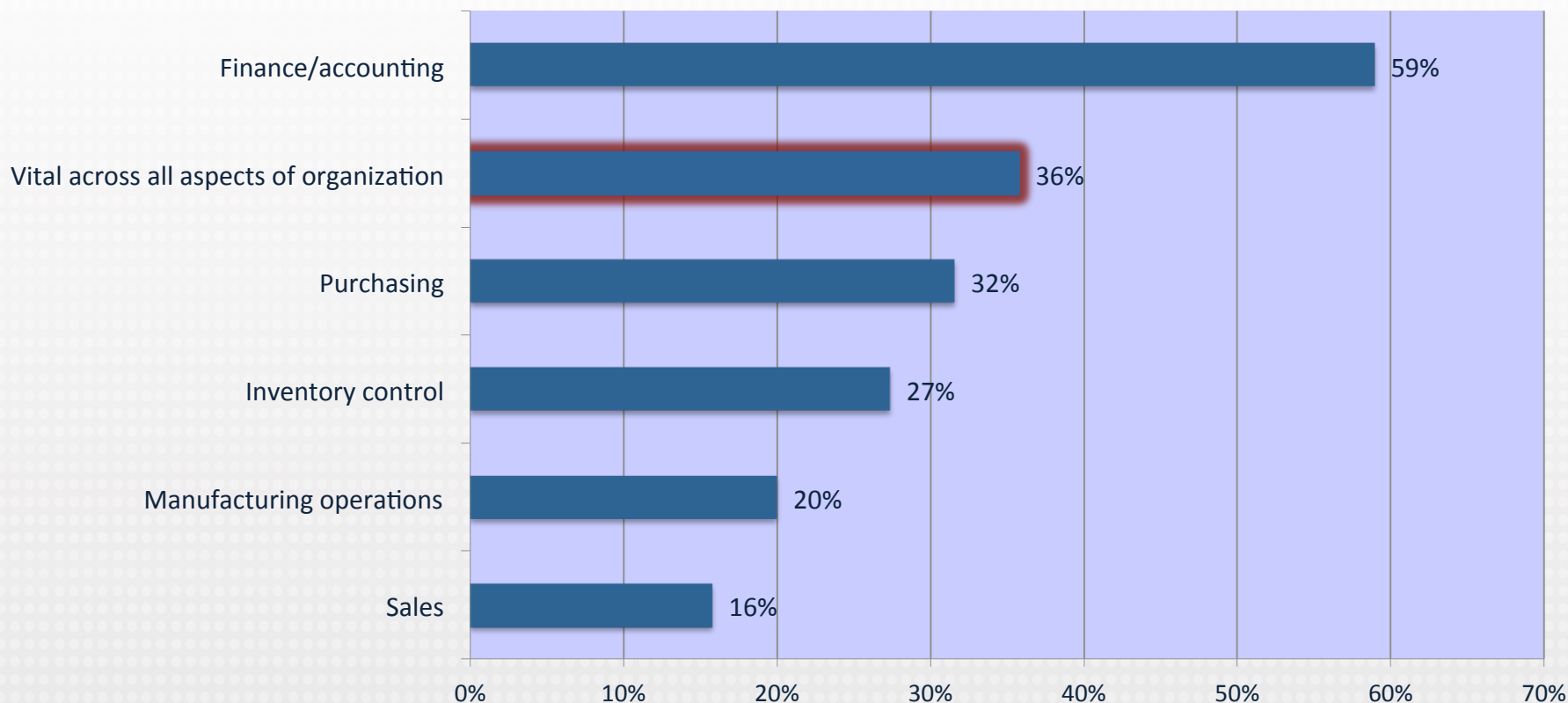
74% of responders are looking to optimize their production process.

What ERP system(s) do you use?



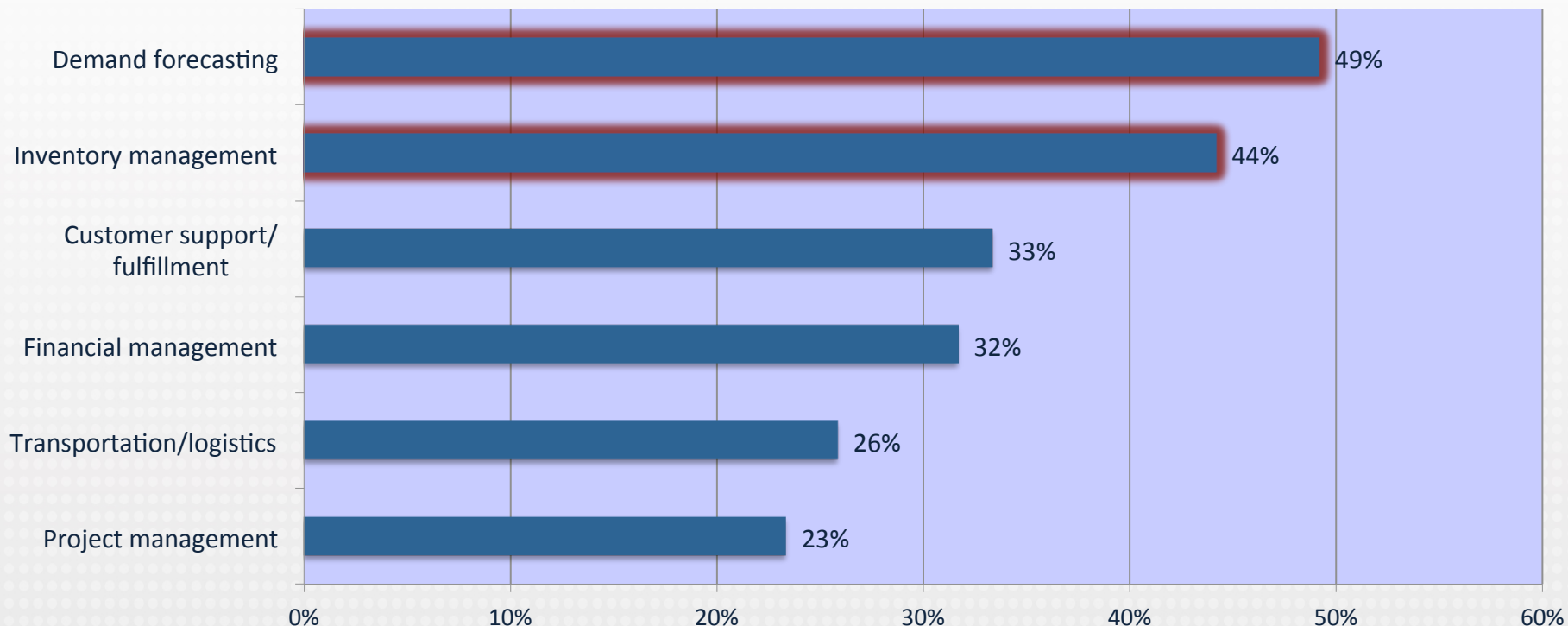
Responders use a wide variety of ERP systems, spread throughout the market.

39% of responders report that their ERP system is vital across all aspects of their organization.

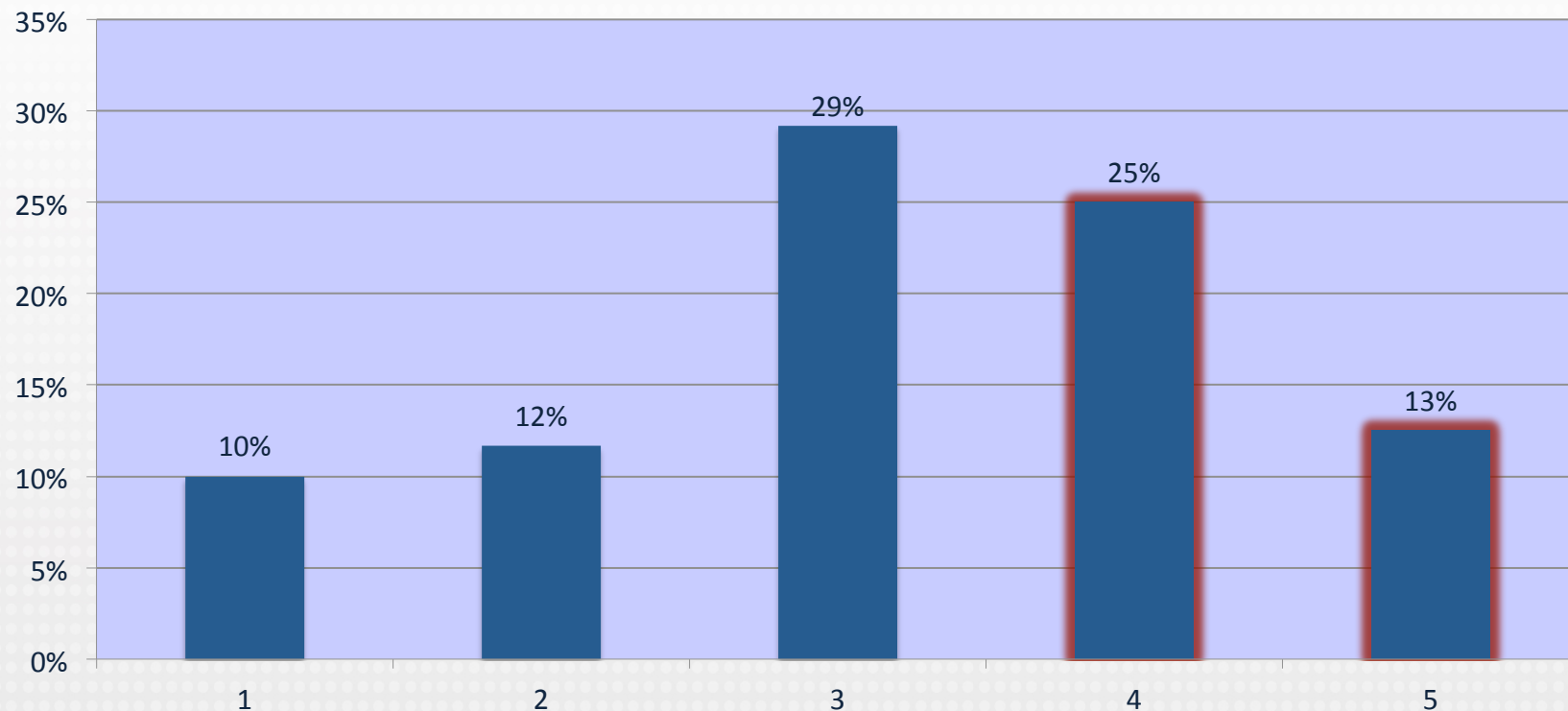
Which of the following processes offer the best potential for improvement?



Demand forecasting (49%) and inventory management (44%) show the most potential for process improvement.

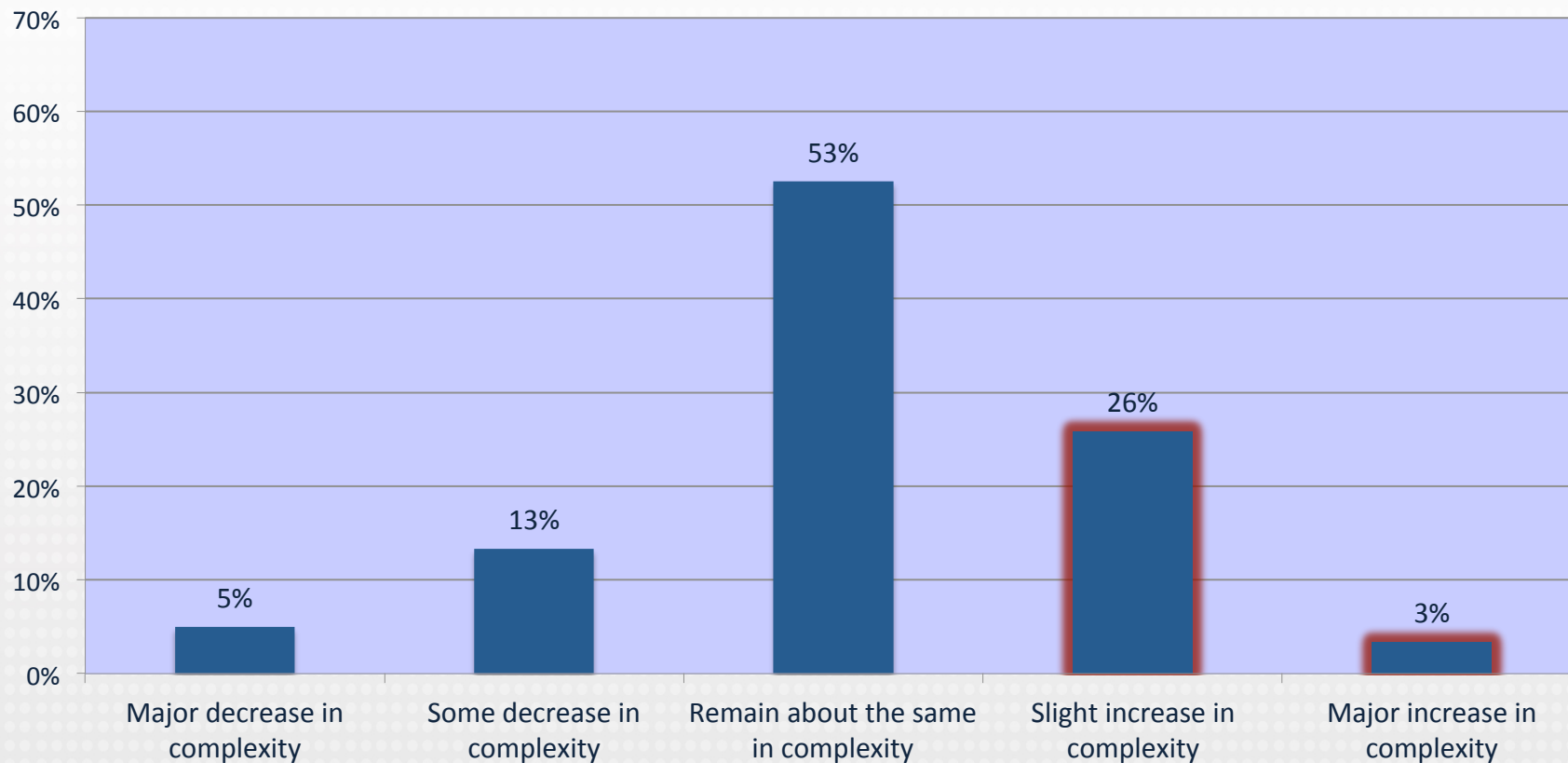
How complex are your manufacturing operations?

(Rate on a scale of 1-5, 1 = minimal complexity, 5 = extremely complex)



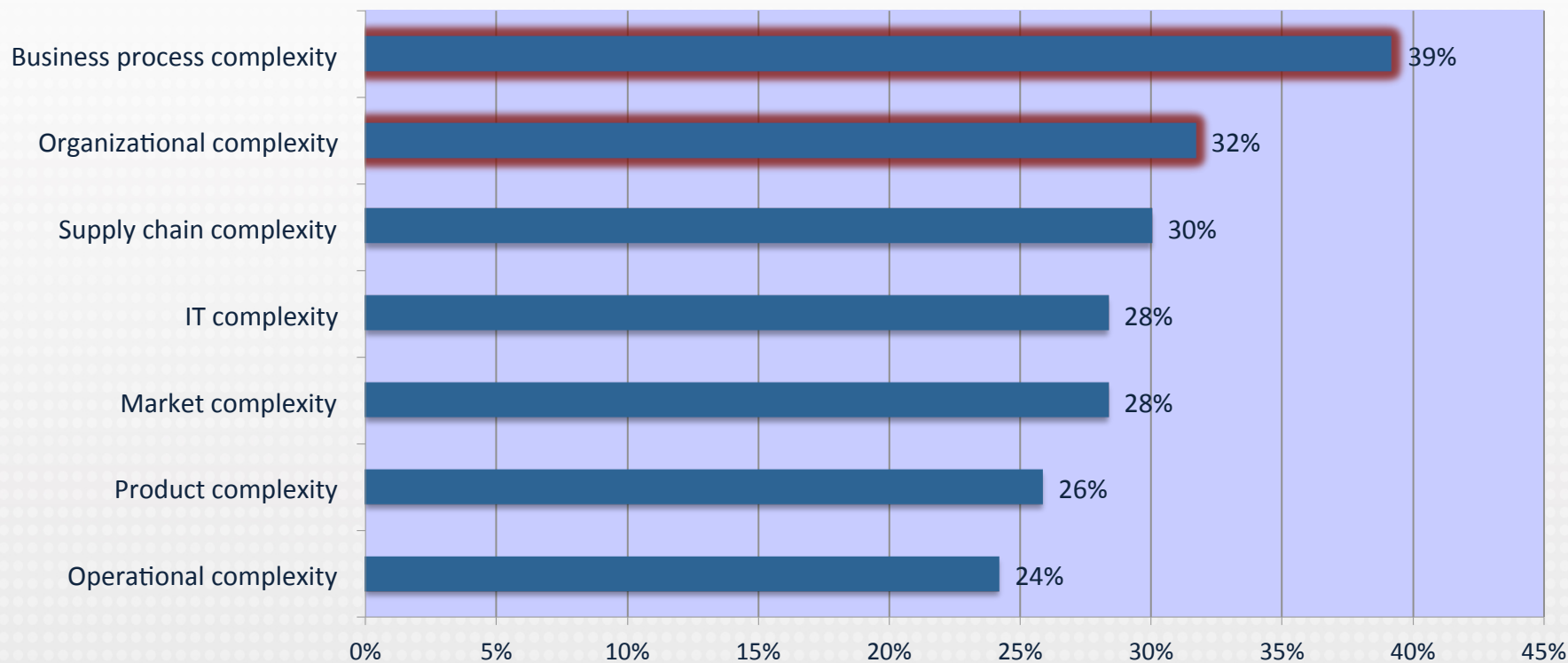
*Manufacturing operations are increasingly complex –

29% of responders forecast an increase in the complexity of their operations.

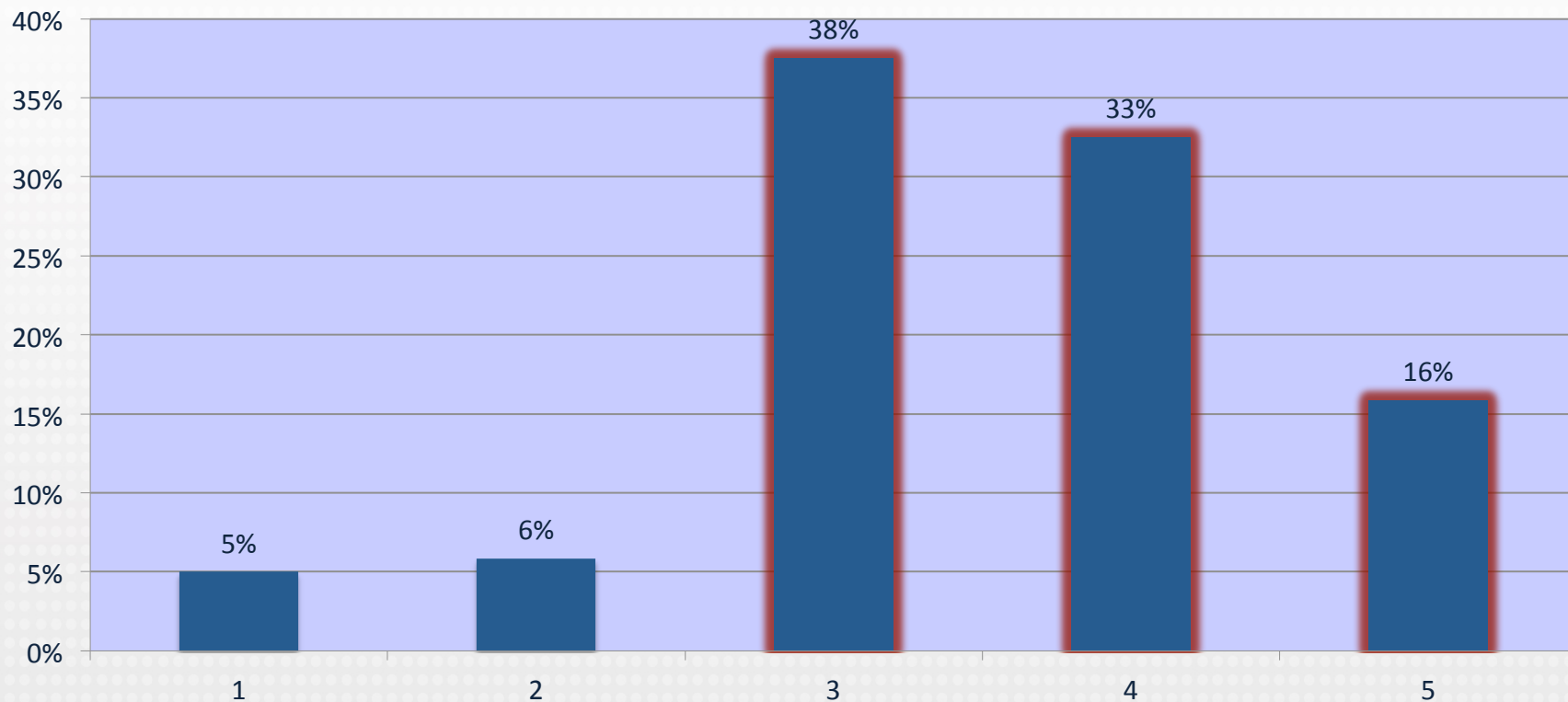
Which areas of your operations may experience the greatest growth in complexity?

32% in organizational complexity.*

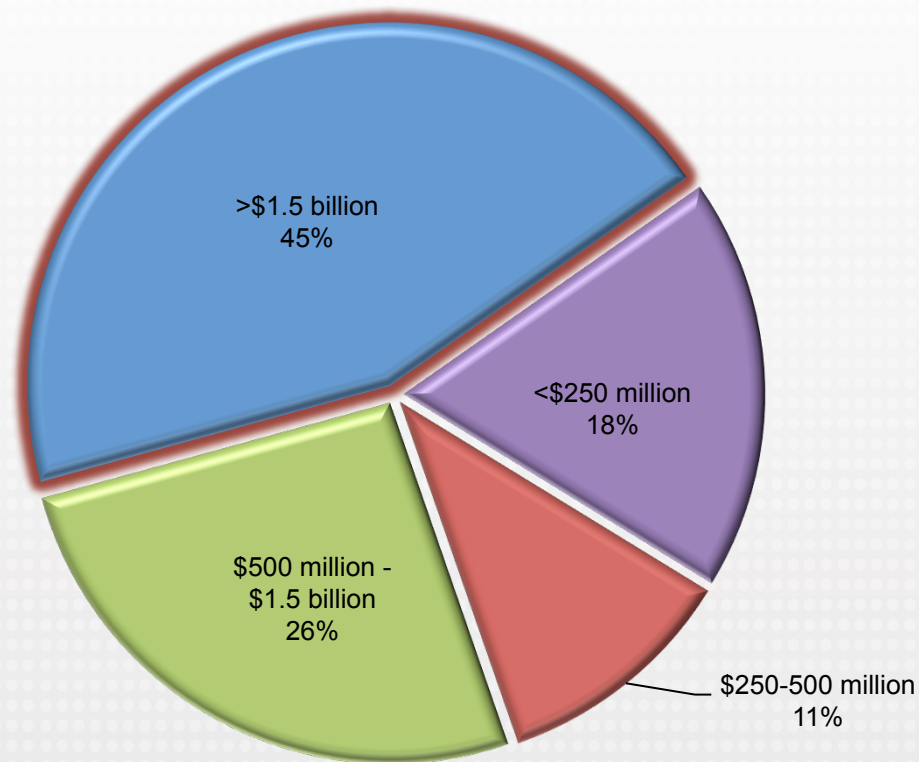
To what extent is your organization addressing such increases in complexity?

(Rate on a scale of 1-5, 1 = not on radar, 5 = regarded critical to address)



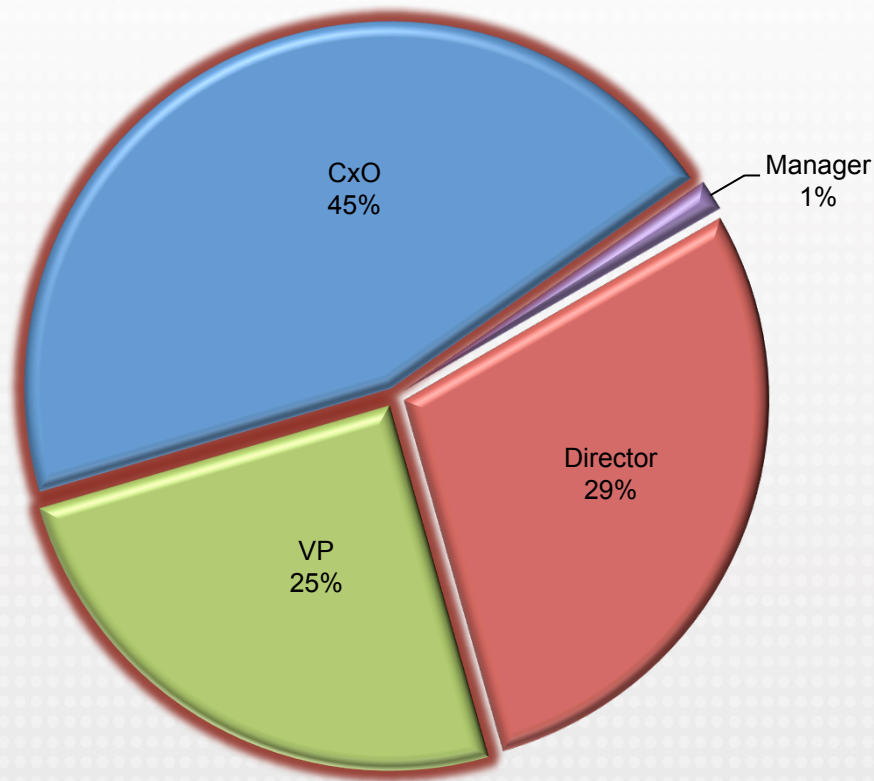
Conquering complexity is key: 87% rate addressing its challenges as 3 or above on a 5 point scale.

Profile of Responders: Revenue

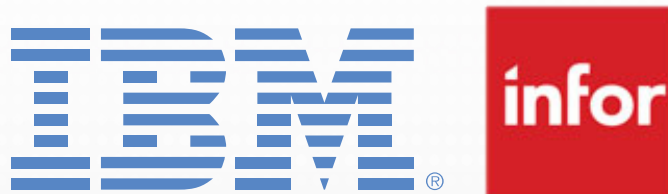


45% of responders work for corporations in the Fortune 1,000.
