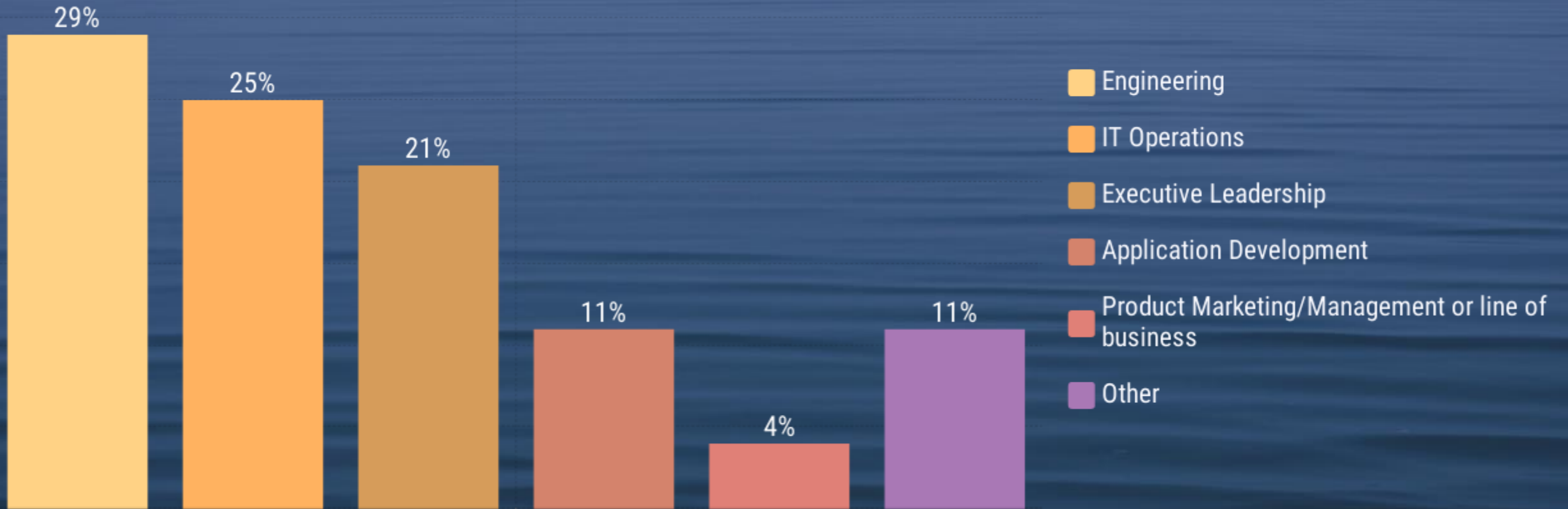
# EXECUTIVE OVERVIEW

This survey asks respondents to report:

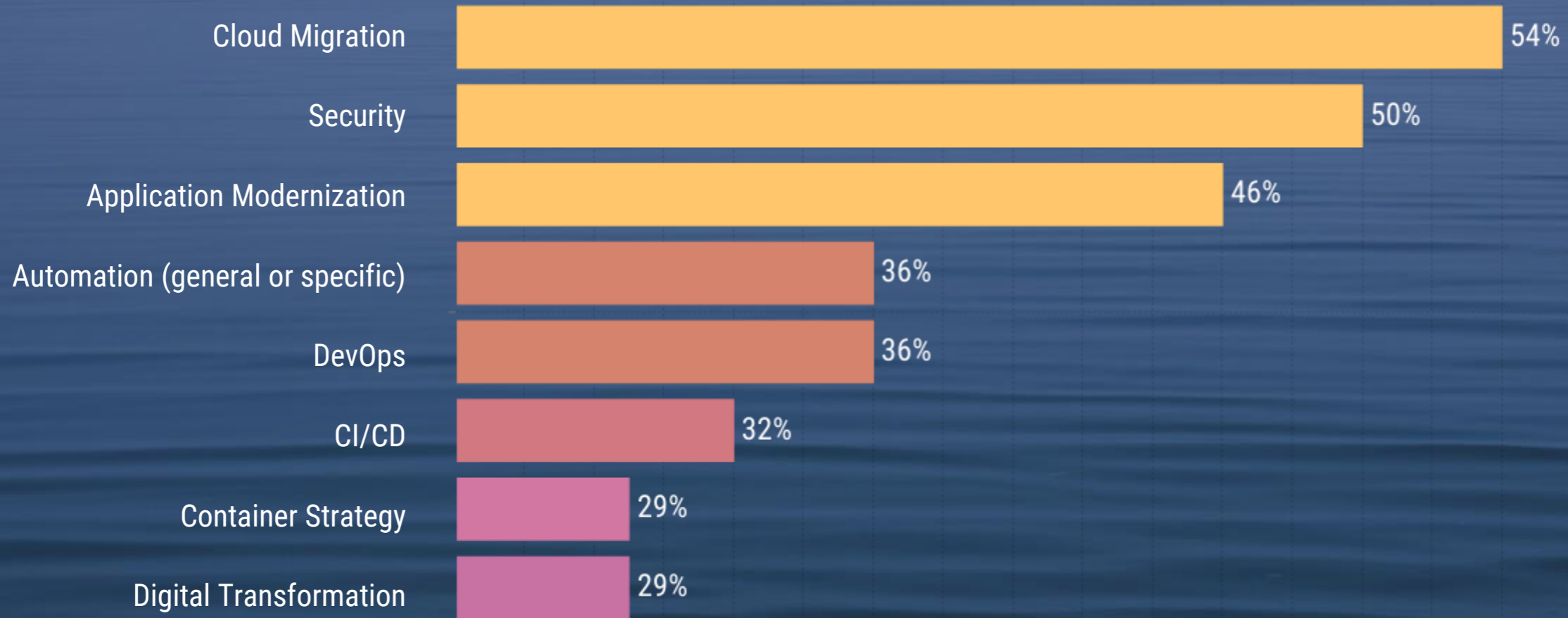
- What do you use IT automation for within your company?

*Three quarters of those responding to the survey report to one of three organizational teams: Engineering, IT operations, or Executive Leadership.*

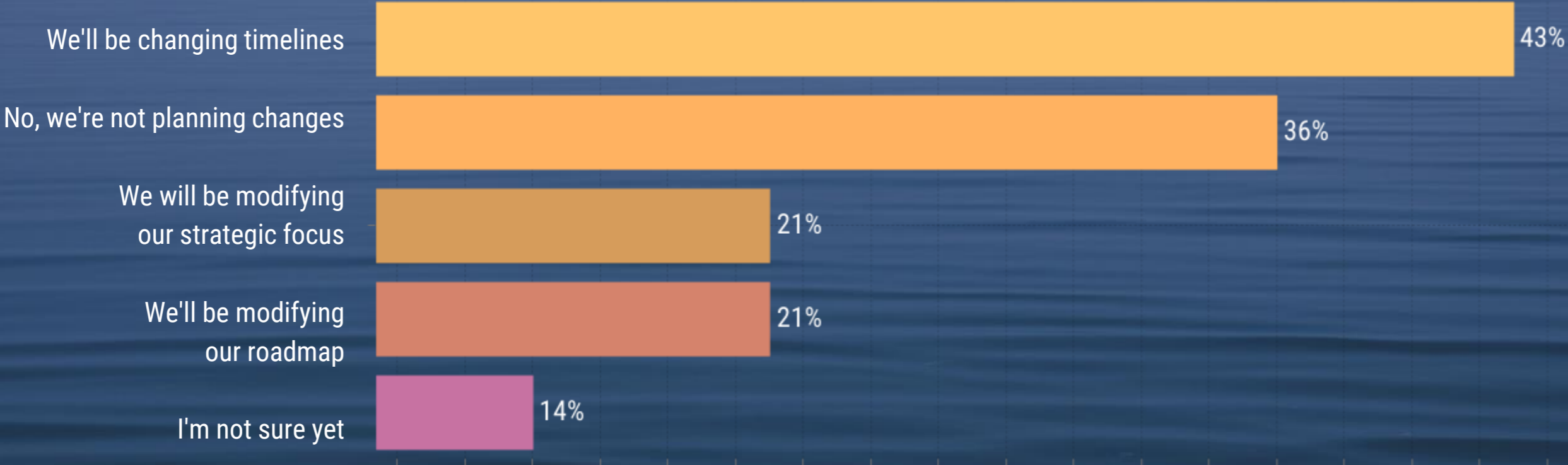
# At the start of 2021, what were your top three IT priorities?



*Top 3 IT priorities cited this year among respondents: cloud migration, security, and application modernization.*

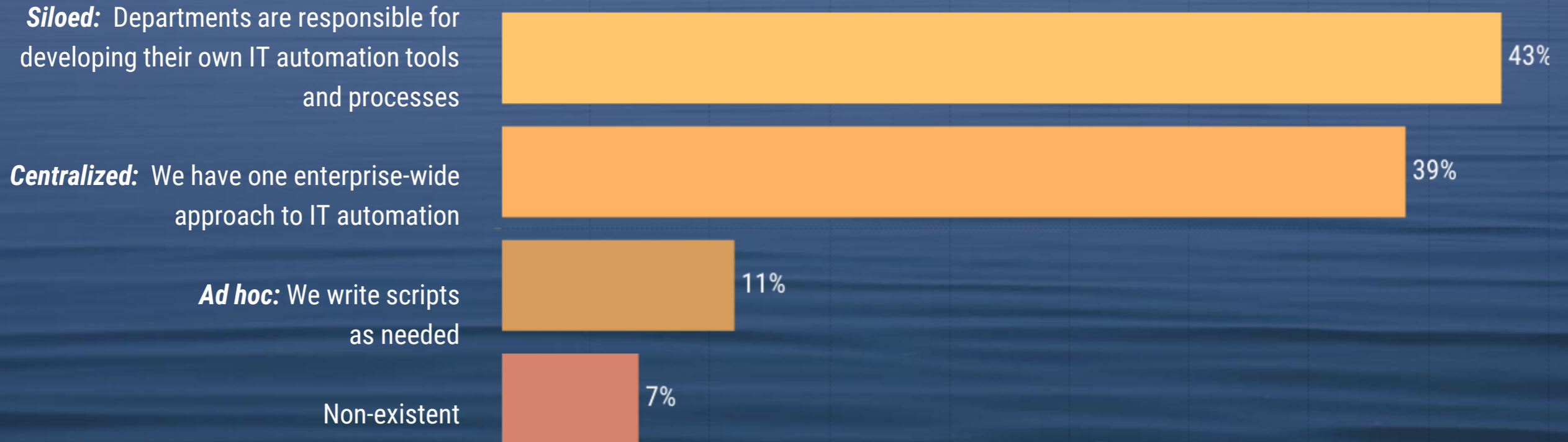


# Have the global events of 2020 resulted in any major changes to your IT strategy or roadmap?



*More than a third of respondents report they are resolutely staying the course in their IT strategy, unchanged by the pandemic and related events. But 43% are changing their timelines, and 42% plan to change either their strategic focus or roadmap... or both.*

# What best describes your IT automation efforts to date?

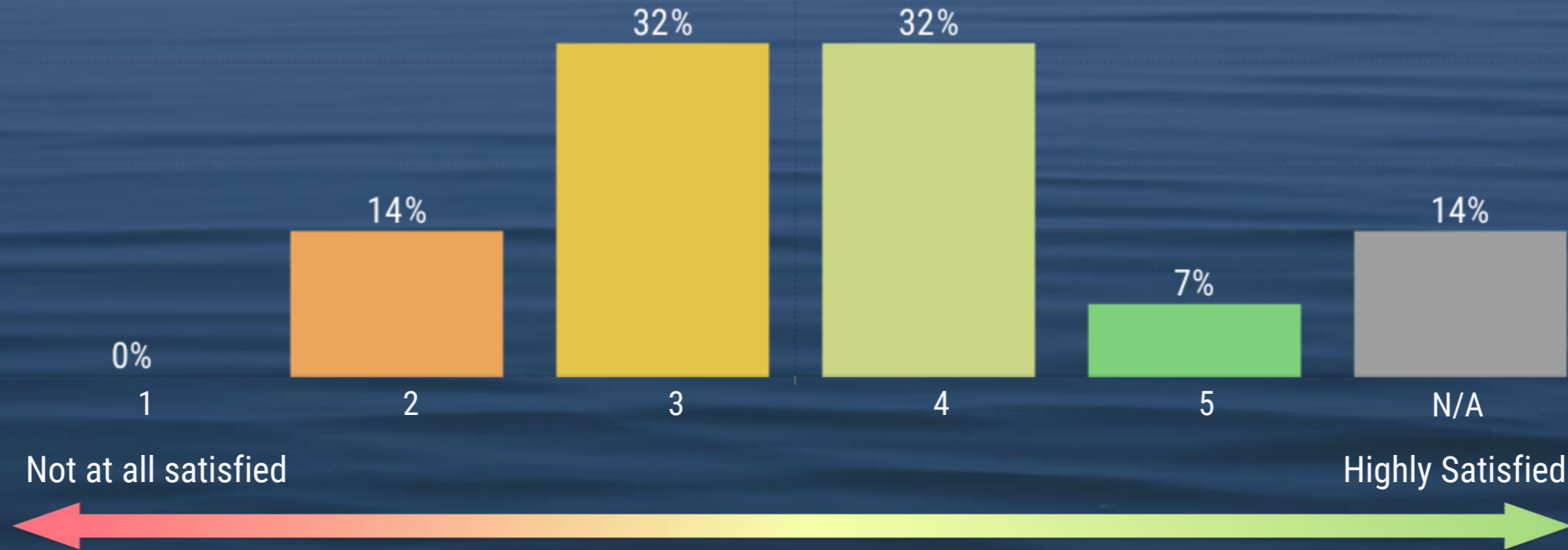


*43% of respondents say their IT automation efforts are patchwork, siloed within departments. A centralized, enterprise-wide automation strategy is reported by 39%.*

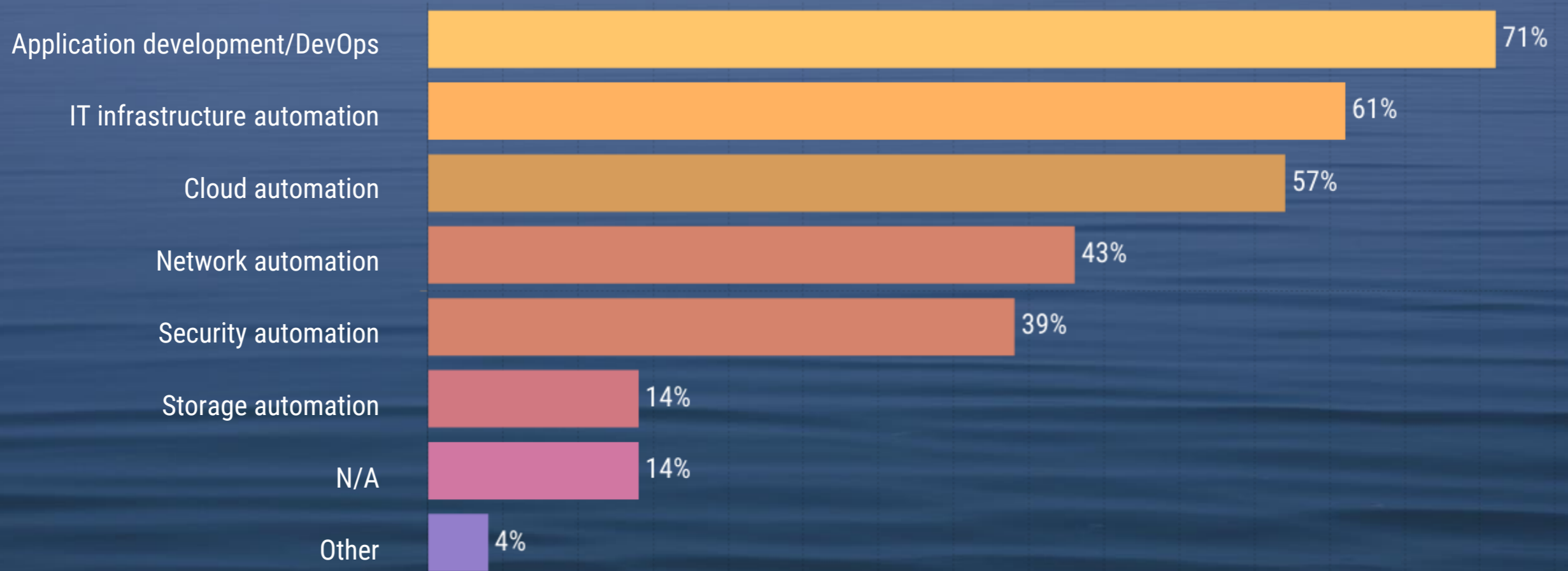
# How satisfied are you with your IT current automation platform? ?

(Rate 1 to 5: 1= not at all satisfied, 5 = highly satisfied)

*Satisfaction with their current IT automation platform is decidedly middling, with only 7% highly satisfied.*



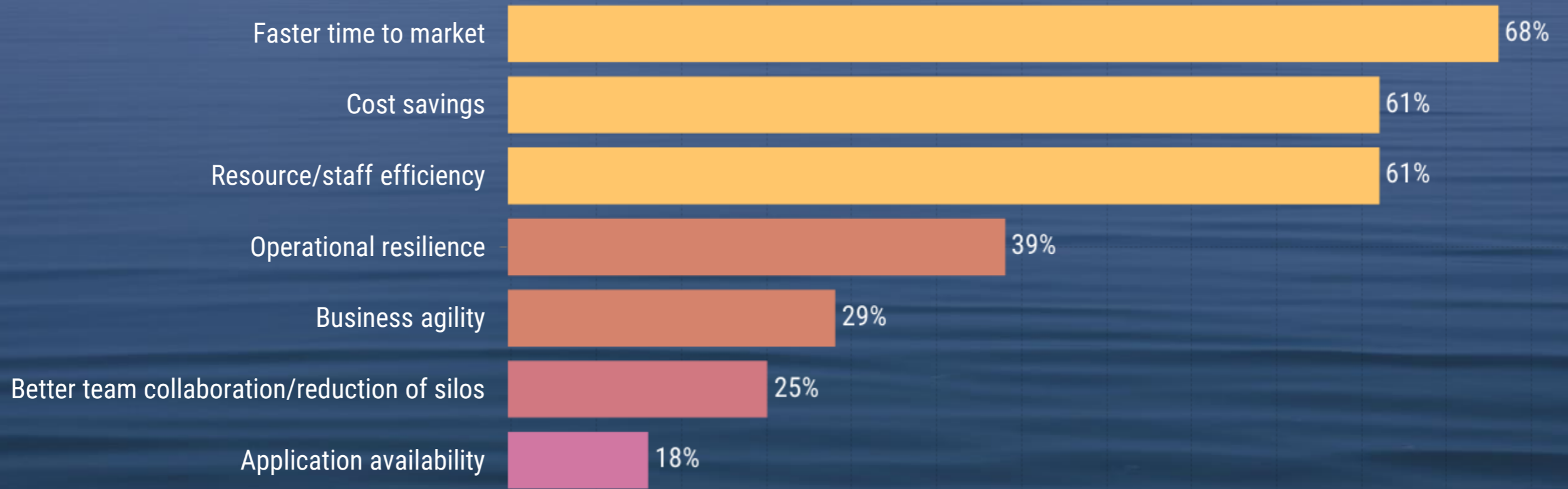
# What do you use IT automation for within your organization?



*Most organizations surveyed are using IT automation for application development/DevOps (71%), IT infrastructure (61%), and cloud automation (57%).*

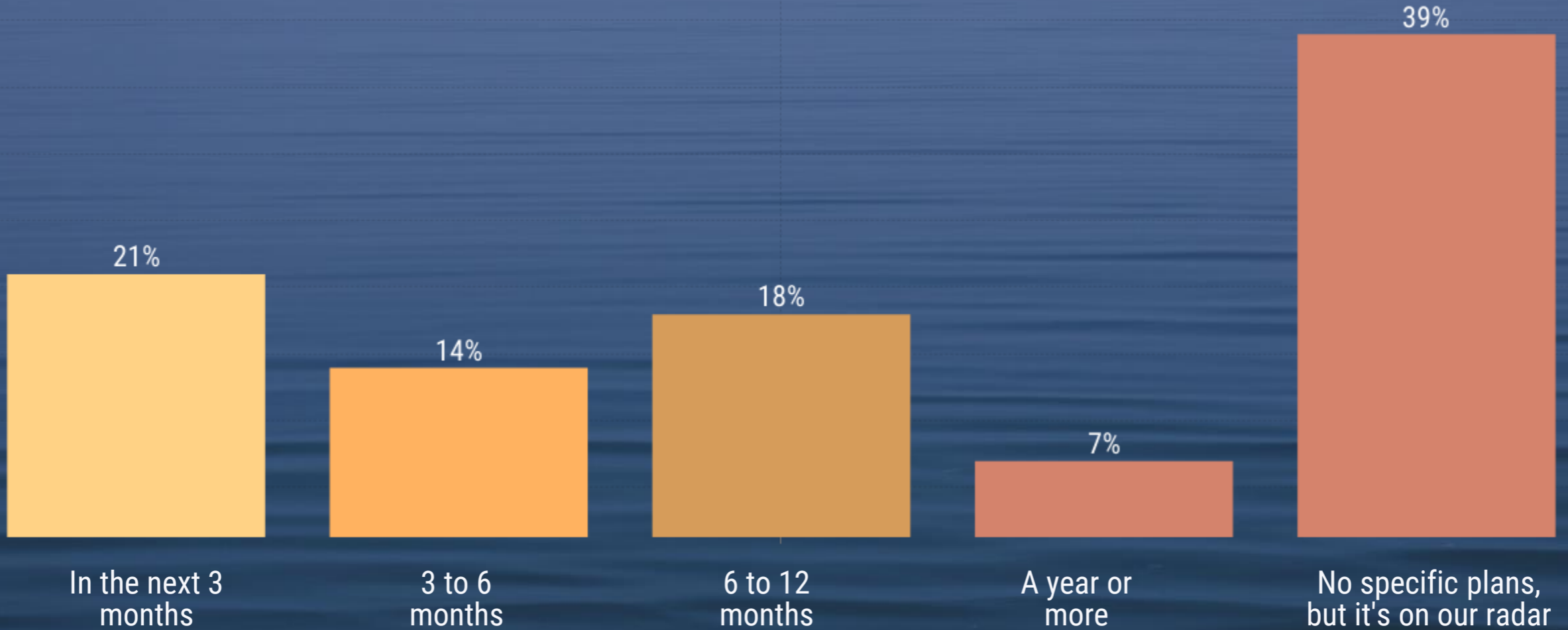


# What would be the three most significant benefits of IT automation for your organization?



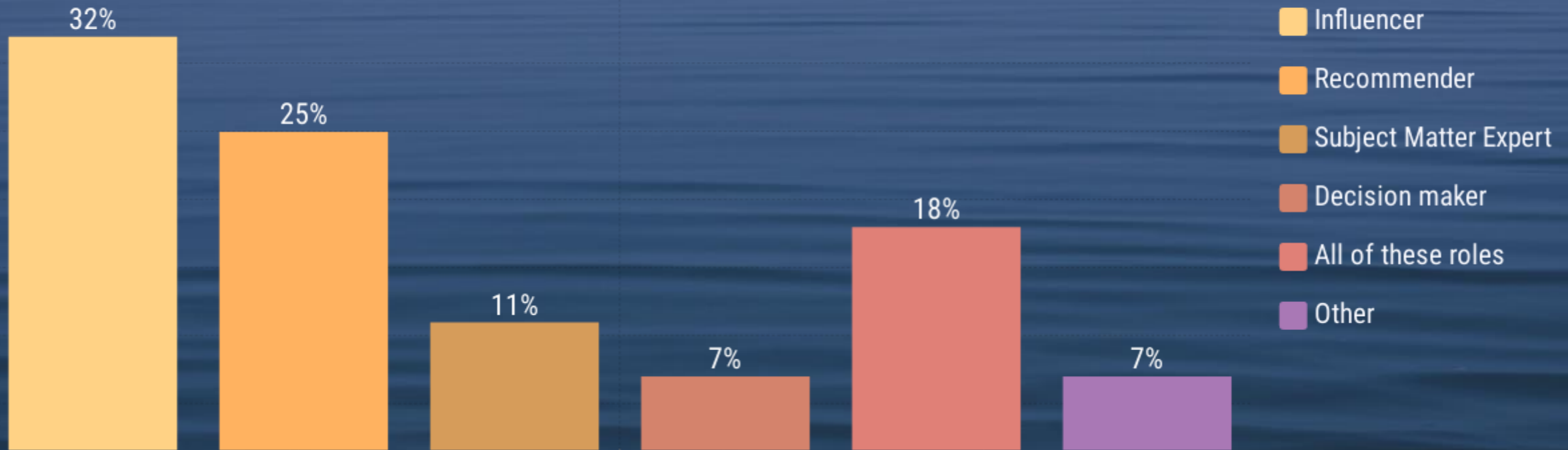
*Top 3 IT automation benefits respondents want to see: faster time to market (cited by 68%), cost savings, and greater resource/staff efficiency (61% each).*

# When do you plan to implement/increase IT automation in your organization?



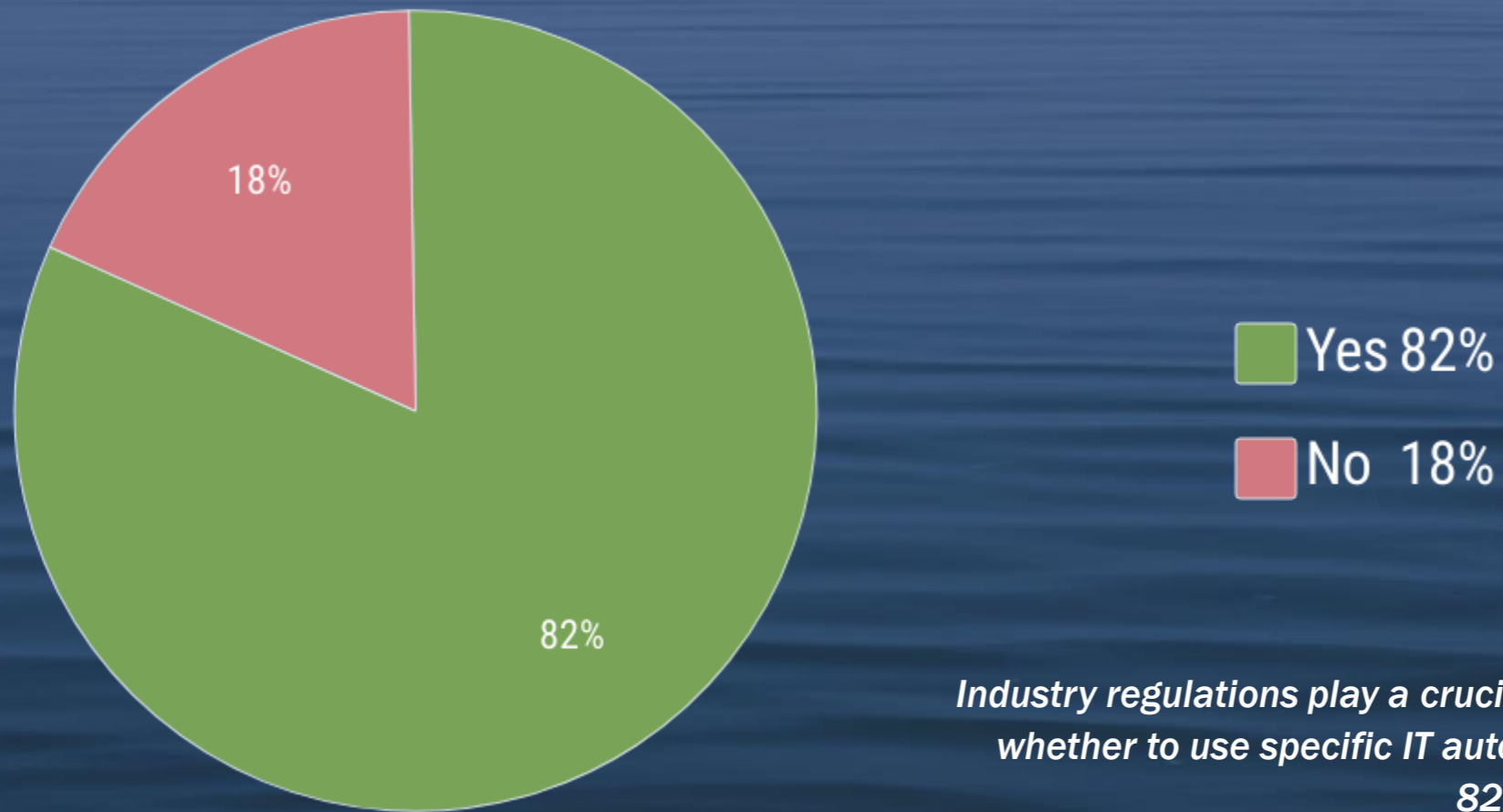
*More than half of those surveyed (53%) report plans to implement or increase IT automation within the year.*

# What is your usual role when your organization makes technology purchasing decisions?



*7% of those surveyed are their organization's technology purchasing decision maker - and another 18% fulfill that role after participating in all other aspects of the buying process!*

# Does your organization have industry-specific regulations (e.g., PCI, HIPAA, etc.) that would factor into your decision to use an IT automation tool?



*Industry regulations play a crucial role in deciding whether to use specific IT automation tools, say 82% of respondents.*
